Biographical Sketch

Jean Rodehaver was a registered nurse and participated in many health and business organizations in El Paso, Texas. She attended Cathedral High School (then co-educational) and El Paso High School. Married to Zachery "Jack" Rodehaver, they had a son, Captain Zachery E. "Jackie" Rodehaver, Jr. Jean Rodehaver later received her diploma in nursing from Hotel Dieu and became a private registered nurse. She attended the ground breaking ceremony for the Hotel Dieu Hospital on April 30, 1950.

Jean Rodehaver became head of the El Paso Graduate Nurses' Association, District No. 1 in January 1951. After her term as president, she served as secretary to the El Paso Graduate Nurses' Association District No. 1 and as a delegate representing the organization at council meetings in other locations across the United States.

Rodehaver also served two terms as president of the Hotel Dieu Alumnae Association and later became the chairwoman of the Hotel Dieu Tiny Tot Association. She was a prominent member of the El Paso Business and Professional Women's Club, where she worked as the Chair of Health and Safety, Chair of Publication, and Director. Additionally, Rodehaver was active in other clubs and organizations related to the medical field, such as the Advisory Hospital Council and the Mental Hygiene Society.

Series Description or Arrangement

The Jean Rodehaver nursing papers are arranged in six series:

Series I. Papers and Reports, 1907-1974

Series is divided into four sub-series – Texas Graduate Nurses' Association, Correspondence, Reports, and Ephemera. All sub-series are arranged chronologically.

Series II. Newspaper clippings, 1948-1976

Series is divided into three sub-series – Dallas (Dallas Morning News), Galveston (The Galveston County Daily News), and San Francisco (San Francisco Examiner), San Antonio (The San Antonio Express), and El Paso (El Paso Herald-Post and The El Paso Times), and Lubbock (The Avalanche-Journal). Sub-series are kept as they were found,

separated by Convention events and dates. All sub-series are arranged chronologically.

Series III. Publications, 1951-1965

Series is divided into two sub-series – Articles and Bulletins and Newsletters. All sub-series are arranged chronologically.

Series IV. Photographs, 1966, undated

Arranged chronologically.

Series V. Certificates, 1974-1980

Arranged chronologically.

Series VI. Scrapbooks, 1938-1960, undated

Series is kept in the original order that Jean Rodehaver created. (See **Notes to the Researcher**)

Scope and Content Notes

The Jean Rodehaver papers date from 1907 to 1980, bulk 1955. Types of records include correspondence, reports, ephemera, newspaper clippings, publications, photographs, certificates, and a scrapbook. The Jean Rodehaver papers date 1907 to 1980, bulk 1955, and are divided into six series (Papers and Reports, Newspaper clippings, Publications, Photographs, Certificates, and Scrapbooks). These papers help document Rodehaver's career, family life, and the field of nursing in El Paso, Texas.

The Papers and Reports series consists of the history of the El Paso Graduate Nurses' Association, annual reports, and programs related to the Association. The series also includes correspondence to Rodehaver from Texas Western College about the College of Nursing and the Professional Nurses Reserve and Research Institute (PNR & RI). Additionally, this series contains a report on nursing resources in Texas and paper ephemera, which includes a cardboard frame, tag, receipts, and a brochure.

The Newspaper series consists of clippings from various newspapers from California and Texas about conventions and events pertaining to nursing or the Texas Graduate Nurses' Association, and there are a few clippings concerning Rodehaver's son "Jackie" who served in the military.

The Publications series include articles from the *American Journal of Nursing*, a newsletter in Spanish from Cruz Roja Mexicana, and a bulletin from the District No. 8 San Antonio Graduate Nurses' Association.

The Photographs series contains photos from Rodehaver's friends, family, and work.

The Certificates series consists of proclamation certificates from the mayor of El

Paso, Texas honoring Texas Nurses Week.

The Scrapbooks series consists of a scrapbook that include newspaper clippings, photographs, letters, various greeting cards, name tags and ribbons, yearbooks, annual reports, a ledger list, a Hotel Dieu graduating class list, post cards, and newsletters.
