Biographical Sketch

Hal Marcus, an artist and gallery owner, was born in 1951 in El Paso, Texas. He comes from a family of Syrian immigrants who owned a grocery store on Dyer Street and Mesa Street. Growing up Marcus was influenced by daily trips to Juárez with his grandmother. Although he has no formal art training beyond high school, Marcus prides himself on being a well-traveled artist who explores artistic forms and meanings in various cultures. Marcus has traveled to Argentina, Brazil, France, Italy, Spain, Greece, Israel, Algeria, China, Turkey, and throughout Mexico.

Marcus is a well-respected artist within the El Paso community and many organizations have collaborated with him for fundraising purposes. These organizations include La Fe Clinic, the Rio Grande Food Bank, Planned Parenthood of El Paso, the United Way, and the Sun Bowl Association. Marcus also has numerous art installations found throughout El Paso. Artwork can be found at the University of Texas at El Paso's Library, the El Paso Public Library Central Branch, Temple Mt. Sinai, the Chamizal National Memorial Theater, Scottish Rite Temple, Ronald McDonald House and the El Paso County Courthouse. Many of his paintings hang in the lobby of University Medical Center Children's Hospital, and St. Pius X Catholic Church is home to 21 stained-glass windows.

Marcus has been an advocate for the El Paso and Juárez communities. He promoted literacy by writing, illustrating, and publishing the book *Animal Alphabet Album*. He also toured schools and libraries throughout Texas with this project.

In 1996 Marcus opened his own gallery, the Hal Marcus Gallery, in grandparents' former home at 2430 N. Mesa in El Paso. The Gallery, later in a different location, 1308 N. Oregon, housed his recent works, reproductions, cards, and books. The Gallery regularly hosts other artists and projects within its doors and specializes in early El Paso art.

Marcus's notable works include: *El Paso Gracias a Dios, My Life, My Friends, My World, El Mercado Juárez, Seven Days of the Creation of the World, El Paso Navidad Niños Del Sol, The Four Seasons/Four Directions of El Paso Series, and Bowie Bakery*.

Hal Marcus was honored with a street named after him, Hal Marcus Place, in 1996. He also received honors and awards from the University of Texas at El Paso in 1999 for his contributions to the university. He was inducted into the El Paso Artists Hall of Fame in 2003. He gifted President Barack Obama a proof of *El Paso Gracias a Dios* in 2010.

Series Description or Arrangement

This collection is divided into five series: Biographical, Correspondence, Photographs and other media, Publications and printed material, and Creative work.

Series 1: Biographical – newspapers, newspaper clippings, notes, photocopies, programs, pamphlets, speeches, flyers, invitations, postcards, and artwork. Arranged in chronological order.

Series 2: Correspondence – incoming and outgoing correspondence. Arranged in chronological order.

Series 3: Photographs and other media – photographs, cassette tapes, VHS tapes, and DVDS. Arranged in chronological order.

Series 4: Publications and other media – newspaper clippings, articles, pamphlets, brochures, books, advertisements, and albums. Arranged in chronological order.

Series 5: Creative work – maracas, puppets, calendar prints, and notebooks. Arranged in approximate chronological order within material types.

Scope and Content Notes

The Hal Marcus papers, MS 411, dates from 1905-2015. The collection contains materials that document Hal Marcus's childhood, family life, and his career as an artist. The collection also contains correspondence, gifts, books, and creative works.

The **Biographical** series contains photocopies detailing Hal Marcus's family history and descendants. The series also includes correspondence between various individuals and organizations, newspaper clippings, speeches at various events, and invites to galleries and other social events.

The **Correspondence** series contains emails sent to Hal Marcus and his wife Patricia Medici, correspondence between him and UTEP, and letters from Temple Mount Sinai.

The **Photographs and other media** series contains photographs documenting Hal Marcus's family, friends, and artwork. The series also contains cassette tapes, VHS tapes, and DVDs documenting Hal Marcus's art and music ventures.

The **Publications and printed material** series contains books, albums, brochures and articles highlighting Hal Marcus's artwork.

The **Creative Work** series contains notebooks, puppets, maracas, paint brushes, paint palette, and oversized prints of Hal Marcus's artwork.

Provenance Statement

The Hal Marcus papers were donated to the C.L. Sonnichsen Special Collections Department of the University of Texas at El Paso Library on March 29, 1995; February 2, 2000; August 15, 2000; January 1, 2003; August 15, 2004; March 2009; November 17, 2015; and August 17, 2016.
