Discusses early life including trips into Hueco Mountains to gather mesquite and amole for firewood and soap; describes life in Ysleta in 1920s and 1930s; life as a teenager; celebrations of St. Anthony's Day (June 13); traces route of street car from Ysleta to El Paso and the route of old Highway 80; relates stories that the "old men" told when he was a child.
